History of brand

Since 2006, our Pagos del Moncayo winery elaborates wines of both Garnacha and Syrah grapes coming from the Aibar's family vineyards. The philosophy we have, is to make wines with maximum respect for the environment and that truly reflect their origin. To achieve the best value and honesty in our wines, we work both vineyards and vinification process with traditional methods, using our own hands and feet and making the most of natural influences. These efforts have been recognized and certified by the EU within the Eco-Prowine project.

Vineyard

- La Corona (Garnacha) and Los Blanquizaes (Syrah) in Magallón (low-altitude zone of Campo de Borja).
- Avg. 350-450 metres high.
- BIO cultivation and controlled low yielding (6,000 kg/Ha). 50% of the grape bunches are discarded in order to ensure the maximum quality of the remaining grapes.

Fermentation & Ageing

- Manual harvest and use of small boxes of less than 19 kg.
- Maceration and alcoholic fermentation at low temperature in open vats holding up to 5 tons, during 1 week.
- Traditional and pampered grape crush by feet in open vats to get the best character of the free run juice and minimize damage of skins and pips.
- Direct blending in open vats.

Winemaker's notes

Dark ruby color. Extrovert nose of well ripe black fruit from the Syrah grape and Mediterranean scrublands like thyme, rosemary and even lavender, representative of Garnacha from Campo de Borja. On the palate, it is pleasantly jammy but fresh thanks to its herbal hues, also present in the aftertaste. Definitely, it is a social wine. It is open, complex but easy-drinking thanks to its fresh character, soft tannins and silky long finish.

Service suggestions

Serve as accompaniment to red meats and pasta dishes. Serve at 14 °C.
